1 Cocolle Kanaiwa



"Soramiso" is a cafeteria that serves great "miso soup", but their specialty is "omusubi" which is a kind of rice ball. Their miso soup uses traditional miso and a lot of ingredients. Their "omusubi" is handmade, using local rice and ingredients. In this café, you can enjoy the taste of "real" Japanese food.

2 Kanaiwa Feudal Manor



Kanaiwa Feudal Manor is a hot spring nearby a Kanazawa Port. Springs are outing of 1,300 meters below around and sodium chloride. It works for backache and neuralgia. Many local people are visiting everyday. In this place, you can enjoy conversation with local people and recover from your tiredness.

3 Aburayo Shop



Aburayo Shop is a local food store that cooks and sells traditional local delicacies. Especially, "roe of globefish" (the egg of the globefish) and "konkaduke" (fish soaked in rice bran) that are delicious. You can't eat them in another place. You have to try them!

4 Ono Minato Shrine



This shrine has a history of 1,300 years and has inherited many cultural assets and traditional performance art. "A Summer festival" is held for 3 days, and this huge famous festival is designated as an intangible cultural heritage of Kanazawa City.

5 Miyanokosi Greenspace



Miyanokosi Greenspace is at the center of the shopping street of Kanaiwa. It's a quiet space as if it were another world. It is a park representing the beauty of Japan that has been passed since long ago.

6 Akiba Shrine



I think that the scenery is beautiful near the sea and appropriate for taking photos. This shrine is located in the place where you pass through the house. Next to the park, there is a big stone monument.

1 Iki Iki Seafood Market



Iki Iki Fish Market is a local market near Kanazawa Port. A lot of fresh local seafood and "dried fish soy sauce" is lined up. Especially at the season of crab and sweet shrimp were crowded with many people. As soy sauce is a famous from the city, seafood rice bowls and lunch boxes are sold in the market. Please stop by once by all means.

2 Ono Port Cafeteria



Ono Port Cafeteria serves Chinese food. It was also used in a movie called "Shiawase No Kaori". It has nostalgia and warmth. I recommend "Ono soy sauce ramen" which used local Ono soy sauce. It is delicious and very friendly taste.

3 Yamato Koji Park (Yamato Soysauce & Miso)



There are a lot of things to see, feel and enjoy at Yamato Koji Park ("Koji" is molted rice). If you will book, you can enjoy English tours by foreign staff, and experience hand bath which make your skin smoother. In addition, there is a restaurant "Hakkoshoku Bijin Shokudo (Cafeteria cultivating beauty inside & out by fermented foods concept)", where you can taste healthy and delicious food. There are a wide variety of seasonings, so please try to find your favorite on.

4 Ono Karakuri Memorial Museum



It is said that the Karakuri Memorial Museum located by the sea was built with the image of Kitamae ship. When entering the building, audio explanations of Ono-machi by Karakuri dolls begin. Inside, there is a large space and there is a hands-on section of Karakuri Puzzle. You can experience, see and touch. Please try playing with own your hands.

5 Hiyoshi shrine



A big festival is held every year at the end of July at Hiyoshi Shrine. It is called "Sanno Festival". It is crowded with a lot of people as one of the three Kanazawa festivals. On the day, the locals will show lion dancing and draw the hill of Hikiyama. It is a summer scene that everyone is looking forward to from children to elderly people.

6 Ono Odaiba Park



Ono Odaiba Park is a big park along the ocean. You can see the Kanazawa harbor by climbing the hill. Also, there are objects of a large ship, and you can take a relaxing break.
